Our Targets for Year One

- Identify a team of people willing to offer care and support to Glapthorn residents in times of need. Put together a role outline, and invite those interested to take part in training. Formulate a strategy for supporting the village.
- @ Refresh the village newsletter and church website, highlighting what is currently offered by the church.
- ⊕ Establish links with two charities a local one and an overseas one.
- Encourage younger church members to join the PCC (Parochial Church Council).
- Formulate a holistic plan for building improvements, accounting for the pressing needs, and the longer term
