Additionally, the problems with the leaking roof (see below) mean that the roof repairs should be undertaken before any lighting is changed. The PCC agreed to put the lighting project on hold for now, and thanked Anne for her work on all of the applications for grants submitted to date. Anne will now write to the Laing Family Trust AEC (who have promised a grant on condition that other monies required are raised in full) and update them regarding the lighting project. All The P.C.C. agreed that in due course, an update should go in the village newsletter about the roof repairs and lighting project.

• Funding for lead roof repairs

A grant for £5,000 has been secured from the Northamptonshire Historic Churches Trust and is

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	valid for three years. The PCC discussed the proposal (attached). Brigitte proposed the authorisation of temporary repairs at a cost of £2,187.83 with instructions to the contractor to investigate and, if possible, repair the other sources of leaks (extra cost unlikely to exceed £1,500). This proposal was seconded by Tracey Kerr and all present voted in favour. It is hoped that the temporary repairs will be done at the end of May. The second proposal — to hold a meeting of the PCC to specifically talk about the roof repairs and the strategy for dealing with it - was agreed and a date of 3 rd June at 7 p.m. in Church set for the meeting.
